

The Surgery Quality and Workflow Manager (SQWM) project aims to deliver functionality that will benefit veterans by implementing a SQWM software solution, which will allow the tracking of surgery patients through the pre-surgical process, scheduling of surgery, and the peri-operative period. Centricity® Perioperative, a Commercial-Off-The-Shelf (COTS) software package is being implemented in conjunction with interface capabilities to share information with VistA and other VA Services to satisfy the desired requirements.

This document provides instructions for the installation and configuration of Oracle Weblogic Application Server, the Internet Information Service (IIS) software, and the SQWM Interface Gateway (SIG) Server that includes Mirth Connect on the Surgical Quality Workflow Management (SQWM) development environment. The installation of Centricity® Perioperative is contained in a stand-alone document.
