<b>Test Title:</b> Details View and Entered in Error <b>Description:</b> This covers the functionality of Enter in Error a Simple Vital.			
<b>Pre-Condition(s):</b> User must have access to UI-components. User must have CPRS account with eHMP write up role.			
<b>Post-Condition(s):</b> N/A			
Step Title	Description	Expected Results	Data
Access Entered in Error Modal	Perform the following actions: Select a concept tile from the Vitals applet Select the details view Select the Enter in Error button	The Entered in Error modal appears.  Note: All the fields exist according to wireframe and “ <a href="https://10.1.1.150/#ui-components-demo">https://10.1.1.150/#ui-components-demo</a> ”	
Close button OR “X”	Within the Entered in Error modal, select the “X” or close button.	The modal closes, and the user return to the previous Form.	
Footer	Repeat step 1 and then select the “Enter in Error” button from the footer.	User selects an option within the Reason section and then selects “Enter in Error” button.	
Check All button	Select the “Check All” button	All Vital checkboxes on the form are checked and button should change to “Deselect All”.	
Deselect All button	Select the “Deselect All” button	All Vital checkboxes on the form are un checked.	
Reason Radio Buttons	Select an option in the “Reason” section.	The option is selected, and the “Enter in Error” button is enabled.  (Note: The user may only choose one	

		option in the “Reason” section.)	
“Remove” incorrect vitals	Ensure at least one vital checkbox is selected, and then select the “Enter in Error” button.	The Entered in Error modal closes, and the user is returned to the previous screen, where the selected vitals have been “removed”.	
Cancel	User selects the “cancel” button from the footer.	Alert modal with header and text disabled with a option to “cancel” button and “continue” button	
Cancel Alert	Repeat step 8 and then User selects the “cancel” button from the footer.	Focus should go back to the Cancel button on Entered in Error Modal	
Continue Alert	Repeat step 8 and then User selects the “continue” button from the footer.	Entered in Error Modal should be closed
